### **Description**

We are looking for a teacher or tutor of A-level Biology, who is familiar with the AQA specification and is happy to work with a group of 3 to 6 students. Most of our courses are over 1 year, and the students may be retaking the course in order to improve their grade, or taking the subject for the first time. Either way, a good knowledge of GCSE Biology is assumed. Most of our students are between 18 and 20 years old, although we do often have a couple of mature students who may want to change their career direction. All teaching takes place at the college in Brislington, and we have the normal teaching facilities and equipment for practical work.

### **Conditions**

Teaching is paid by the hour, and this is negotiable depending on experience and group size. We rarely have groups bigger than 5 or 6 students. We would of course hope that the person appointed is able to commit to the duration of the course.

### **Schedule of teaching**

As far as possible we try and accommodate our teacher / tutors personal preferences for their teaching days and times, but once a schedule is agreed we ask that this is not changed for the duration of the course.
